Chairman Smith, members of the Committee, thank you for the opportunity to submit neutral testimony on HB 2139.

Kansas NEA fully recognizes the growing shortage of game officials in KSHSAA sponsored events as well as youth sports in general. Individuals could reasonably cite hostile environments and experiences as contributing factors to these shortages.

Kansas NEA does not wish to weigh in on the larger philosophical legal debate over the creation of additional crimes and punishments regarding the actions and behaviors that take place in the youth sporting environment. We believe that criminal statutes already exist that may suffice if enforced.

Kansas NEA would be remiss as well, if given the chance to discuss increasingly hostile environments, to remain silent about the growing concern of safety in the classroom.

Last year during the hearing for similar legislation, The House Judiciary Committee indulged Kansas NEA with hearing the testimony of three public school educators.
